Journalists

Choose Journalists if you want to report on school life and events, and further your creative writing skills. Publish your writing on the JFS website, and creative writing blog.



What's involved?

- Training day with journalists.
- Write 3 school event reports, and 1 creative writing entry per term.



- School visit to Bloomberg/Sky.
- Work with amazing team of Journalists across all year groups.

How to apply: Write a 300 word report on one of:

- School event e.g. school visit
- Community event outside of school e.g. Mitzvah Day, Football Tournament.
- Local issue e.g. housing, environment, crime, local hero, celebrity.

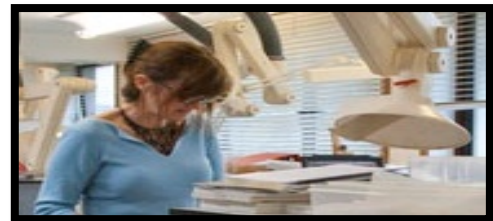
Scholars

Choose Scholars if you want to research scientific discoveries, historical events, philosophical debates, and global issues. Publish your work in the *Scholars Journal*.



What's involved?

- Training day with professors.
- Write 1-2 extended reports on research topic of your choice during the year. .



- School event to British Library exhibition.
- Work with amazing team of Scholars across all year groups.

How to apply: Write a 500 word report on one of:

- A global issue
- A historical event
- A scientific discovery
- A philosophical debate

IMPORTANT: On your application do include your **Name/Tutor Group/EITHER Journalist OR Scholars**. These programmes combine the most keen and able students from each year group. There are around 5 spots in each year group for each programme. Selection is based on quality of writing in application and evidence of good academic progress this year.
