

## Hametz Hunt Clues

Use the clues to help you work out where in the school each Hametz character is hidden !

1. Books must be checked for any hametz crumbs
2. If there is any hametz that has been spoiled by chemicals it does not need to be destroyed
3. Alcohol can be hametz, but if they are in the form of paint or ink they can be kept and used over Pesach
4. Ovens need to be cleaned thoroughly and heated to maximum temperature to make them kosher for use on Pesach
5. People have the tradition to search for hametz using a feather and candle like they did historically in the past
6. A person needs to remove or sell all hametz in the possession in all their property wherever it is in the world
7. There is a concept that we run to do mitzvot to ensure they are done as soon as possible. Therefore we begin our search for hametz immediately after nightfall on Erev Pesach
8. After the search for hametz, a declaration is made to nullify any remaining hametz not found. This should be done in the language you understand best
9. There is custom to place exactly 10 pieces of hametz around the house before the search begins to ensure the person searching does a thorough search
10. No sound should be made after the beracha is said before the search for hametz begins until it completed
