All you need to do is register for the award today at www.jlgb.org/yonijesner.

Registration will give your child exclusive access to the JLGB online volunteering platform, where they can log their hours, as well as searching for local opportunities that match their interests. There are lots of volunteering opportunities on offer, many of which have been adapted to be COVID-safe, meaning your child can get started right away.

Here's some ideas...

- ★ Take on our fundraising challenge and raise vital funds for a treasured charity.
- ★ Collect toiletries and warm clothes and drop them off to your local refugee centre or synagogue drop off.
- ★ Write, telephone or video call an elderly person.
- ★ Tidy the local park and public areas in the community at this time.
- ★ We have partnered up with Light Up a Life this winter where you can find lots of Covid-safe volunteering opportunities in your area. Visit www.lightupalife.org.uk for more information.

As well as giving your child a real sense of purpose, achievement and confidence, once your child has logged 20 or 50 hours they will achieve their Yoni20 Award or Yoni50 Award and if they continue to volunteer 100 hours or more they will achieve the rare Yoni100 Award.
