Dear Student

The Year 12 UCAS examinations will begin on **Monday 7th June** and will finish on **Friday 18th June 2021**; please [CLICK HERE](#) for the Year 12 UCAS Examination Timetable.

In addition, please [CLICK HERE](#) for the Year 12 UCAS Examination information, detailing the rules for the examinations; please read through this information very carefully.

Please note that all wrist watches and mobile phones are not allowed in the exam room. Please ensure that these are locked away in your locker (or Pastoral Office if you do not have a locker) before you come to the exam room.

Year 12 UCAS Examinations are run using the same rules that apply to A-Level examinations, therefore failure to comply with the regulations will result in your paper being disqualified. In accordance with JCQ regulations, you must have identification with you when you are in the examination room, therefore you will only be permitted to enter the examination room if you have your lanyard on you.

You are also expected to fully adhere to the Sixth Form Dress Code when sitting examinations and if you come into school to revise. Students who fail to comply with the Dress Code will not be allowed in the examination room, therefore it is essential that you come to school on the day of your examinations in the correct attire.

The majority of students will take their exams in the Main Hall and all students should go to the Amphitheatre to wait to be called into the exam room. If you are taking your examination in a different room, you will be notified in advance.

Registration for these examinations is at **8.30 am** (for a 9.00 am start) for morning exams and **12.30 pm** (for a 1.00pm start) for afternoon exams (**12.00 pm** for a 12.30 pm start on Friday afternoons). It is your responsibility to ensure that you are there in good time. **Please note the duration of your afternoon exams, in case you need to make alternative arrangements for travelling home.**
