

Dear Year 11 Parents/Carers,

At JFS we want to ensure your child is provided with a full and rigorous curriculum whether that be at home or in school over the coming year.

In a similar way to last year, we cannot assume students will be able to share books or use books that another student has used previously, especially if taken home and returned. We know how challenging the current climate is for your children and for that reason we are hoping each child will have their own set of books to fully access the curriculum without fear.

If your child doesn't have the texts already, you will need to purchase the GCSE books and we suggest you do this through JFS as we get a school discount. It is imperative they bring these texts to all lessons. This will ensure that your child has access to their own copy of each text, to make notes, revise and should the school needs to be closed again or any changes made, students can continue their learning at home with no further need for printing. These are the same texts they used in year 9 and 10 so no need to purchase new ones. The book bundle is £30 if you require the texts.

We will be providing a pre-printed set of class and revision booklets and are requesting a contribution of £6 for this bundle, which will cover the entire year, so again no need for further printing.

We will be putting the books and the booklets together in a bundle which your child will receive during their first few weeks back in school, in September once they have been purchased. **The total cost is £6 for the booklet bundle or £30 if you require the texts as well.**
