## **YEAR 11 TO YEAR 12 TRANSFER – SEPTEMBER 2022**

Your son or daughter will shortly be moving to the next stage of their educational journey by taking their GCSEs and progressing to Sixth Form. JFS has a national reputation for excellence at Sixth Form and is, once again, one of the top performing totally non-selective Sixth Forms in the country at A Level, BTEC and CACHE, with an Ofsted rating of 'Good' in May this year.

I want to outline the events, activities and information - sharing we have organised in order to support the choices you and your children will be making about their transfer to the Sixth Form at JFS next September.

We have just published our new Pathway & Curriculum Guide 2022-23 detailing the outstanding academic and extracurricular provision that is offered at JFS in the Sixth Form. This is now available on the JFS website on the [Sixth Form Transition](#) page where you will also be able to find the [Transfer to Sixth Form form 2022](#) which you can complete to indicate your son's/daughter's provisional subject choices. This will need to be completed by the deadline at **9pm on Sunday 13th February 2022**.

At the start of the Spring Term, in January, there will be the opportunity for your son or daughter to attend up to four taster lessons in order to help them make up their minds about some of the subjects on offer. Mrs Levick has sent an email about this to you already with a [form](#) to complete. The deadline for requesting these taster lessons is **the end of the school day on Monday 6th December 2021**.

You may wish to wait to complete the Transfer to Sixth Form form until after **2nd February 2022** when we are holding a **Sixth Form Prospective Parents' Evening** for you and your child/ren to attend. You will be able to visit the *Edmond J Safra Sixth Form Centre*, meet subject and pastoral staff and hear from the Sixth Form Team about life in the Sixth Form at JFS. Please save the date and look out for more information about this in due course.

In the meantime, the Sixth Form Team have been attending a series of Year 11 assemblies to explain directly to students the process of transition to Year 12. The team will be joined by subject specialist colleagues who teach subjects that your son or daughter may not have encountered previously:

- Psychology
- Business Studies
- Film Studies
- Media Studies
- CACHE Childcare and Education
- BTECs and Applied Courses
- Applied Criminology
