



Different pathways, different choices



University – 3 years – Fees £30K

Job hunting:

No experience – challenging!



Apprenticeship:

Job with salary + studying ~ 3-4 years

Annually salary ~ £20K

Fees: all paid for by employer

Achieve: experience and a degree or professional qualification
