This form must be completed regardless of sibling status. The school cannot consider a CRP which does not have the relevant declarations and it is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to approach the relevant person(s) to obtain a letter of confirmation if they are unable to have parts of the form signed. The relevant person(s) may decline to sign this form where the parent/guardian or the child is not personally known to them and/or cannot vouch for the parent/guardian or the child. SECTION 1. The course is open to all applicants and consists of 6 sessions of 45 minutes, involving both child and parent(s)/guardian(s), covering topics relevant to Jewish customs and practices, festivals, kashrut, etc. All of them need to be completed in order to satisfy this section.
